


CREATIVE Storage Solutions

Home Maintenance Tips

With the potential of winter weather coming our way, here are few things to have and prepare around your home.

- Concrete Safe Ice Melt – Make sure you buy the correct ice melt that is safe for concrete, to protect your porches and walks.



- Locate your Gas Vent and be sure to keep snow or ice from blocking the vent – as soon as the vent is blocked, your gas will automatically shut off as a safety measure, potentially leaving you in the cold and/or without use of your gas appliances.
- Be sure to keep your downspouts and swales clear so water can drain properly. After a measurable snow, if your downspouts and swales are blocked, a large rain can spell trouble. The water could potentially cause leaking around your foundation if the spouts and swales are not clear allowing them to direct water away from your home.
